14. The Graduate Record Examination is required. You should contact the testing office of the nearest college or university and arrange to take the General Test. The Subject Test is also required. Request that your official scores be mailed to the English Department, 107 Tate Hall.
15. All applicants must submit this application, an application to the University, official transcripts, three letters of reference (at least two of which must be academic), GRE general and subject test scores, a statement of purpose and two 10-20 page critical/scholarly papers (one paper for those students applying in Creative Writing). Creative Writing applicants must also submit a 30 page sample of their fiction or creative nonfiction, 20 pages of poetry, or a one-act play. Completed applications are due January 1 for admission the following fall. Applicants for the MA/PhD and PhD track are required also to submit the supplementary information sheet.

II. Application for Fellowship or Assistantship

Recipients of English Department Teaching Fellowships teach three courses per year; two in the fall, and one in the winter semester. Recipients of Creative Writing PhD Teaching Fellowships teach one course per semester. Students with PhD Assistantships teach two courses per semester. Students with MA and MA/PhD Assistantships do not teach their first year, but teach two courses per semester their second year in the program.
